2. The poor performance reflects upon the low interest taken by the Officers-in-Charge in this regard, since more than one month has passed that it was initiated. You are, therefore, advised to call an explanation from the Officer-in-Charge of the above office(s) and those directly in-charge of handling.



Further I may add here that during the course of my visit to several offices and discussions with some officers, it was revealed that while settling a claim, many dealing hands are, as a matter of routine, clicking on a cheque option instead of NEFT option. This is serious breach of discipline and firm action needs to be taken against such delinquent dealing hands if they are not complying with the directions given to them.
