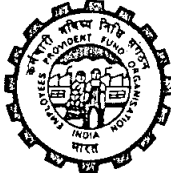

Sub: - Holding of the Regional Committee meetings – Regarding.

Sir,

In continuation of Head Office letter of even number dated 25.06.2009 the undersigned is further directed to say that Hon'ble Minister for Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, has expressed his deep concern on the non-holding of all Committees/ Boards meetings and desired that meetings of all Committees/ Boards should be convened immediately if the same had not been convened in the recent past. As per the information available at Headquarters, during the year 2008-09 very few committees have met even once during the period as may be seen from Annexure –I.

2. As per the provisions of para-11 of the Employees' Provident Fund Scheme, 1952, the Regional Committee, EPF for a state shall meet at least twice in each financial year to deliberate upon the issues mandated under para 4(2) of Employees' Provident Fund Scheme 1952, As has been clarified earlier, during the current financial year also, very few Regional Committees have been convened. The provisions of para 5 of the Scheme made it clear that the term of office of the Chairman and every member of the a Regional Committee for a state shall be three years commencing on and from the date on which their appointment is notified in the official gazette. Every member shall continue to hold office until the appointment of his successor is notified in the Official Gazette. Hence, the meeting of the Regional Committee is required to be convened regularly with existing members until the appointment of its succeeding members is notified in the official Gazette.

3. In view of the above, it is requested that the meetings of the Regional Committee, EPF of your state may be convened regularly and the Chairman of the Regional Committee, EPF, for the State may be approached regularly to convene meetings of the Regional Committee citing the provisions under para 11 of the EPF Scheme, 1952. It is also requested that after completion of financial year 2009-2010 the details of meetings of Regional Committee (EPF) of your region held during the said financial year may kindly be furnished to this office in the format placed at Annexure- II.
