**SUB : SUPPLY OF INFORMATION UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT,
2005.**

Whereas Shri Ganesh Lal Nagda..... has made a request in writing vide his/her application dated 16-11-2009 for obtaining information under Section 6(1) of the RTI Act, 2005.

2. Whereas the undersigned having been appointed as Central Public Information Officer under Section 5(1) of the said Act is required to consider and provide the information within 30 days of the receipt of the request.

3. And whereas Section 5(4) of the Act provides the Central Public Information Officer may seek the assistance of any other officer as he considers it necessary for the proper discharge of his duties. Sub-section (5) further provides that any officer whose assistance has been sought shall render all assistance to the Central Public Information Officer. Once the complaint is referred "for the purposes of any contravention of the provisions of the Act, such other officer shall be treated as Central Public Information Officer" and may be liable for penalties under Section 20 of the said Act. Further in the event of violation of provisions / non-furnishing of documents / information such an officer is liable for penalties under Section 20(1) of the Act @ Rs.250/- for each day of delay which may extend up to Rs.25000/-.

4. And whereas under Section 6(3) of Right to Information Act it has been provided that

"Where an application is made to a public authority requesting for an information :-

- (i) which is held by another public authority; or
- (ii) the subject matter of which is more closely connected with the functions of another public authority,

the public authority, to which such application is made, shall transfer the application or such part of it as may be appropriate to that other public authority and inform the applicant immediately about such transfer."



5. Whereas on scrutiny of the application I find that the information sought by the applicant on the following items :

You may please note that any delay in furnishing the information / documents sought for within the stipulated time limit will attract the penal provision as provided for under Section 20 of the Right to Information Act.

6. This may please be treated as most urgent.





In purauant to the provisions contained under the Right to Information Act. 2005 the underaigned requeat you to kindly supply the following information and required documents. One postal order No. **66F-633956** for Rs. 20/- in favour of 'Central Provident Fund Commissioner' being the fee is enclosed.

Information's and documents required

- (1) *HRM-D* Name and place of posting of all those Stenographers who have been promoted to the post of Personal Assistant out of the **Final Seniority list of Stenographers** (From Sr. No. 1 to 153), issued by EPFO, Head Office Order No. HRM-III/1(6)99/Steno/AIFSL/Vol.III/6991 dated 23.6.2006 by the Head Office.
- (2) *ACR R.O.B* Name of all such stenographers from above mentioned seniority list (in Para 1) of stenographers who has been promoted to the post of PA by all the Regional Offices of EPFO along with their serial number in the seniority list.
- (3) *ACR R.O.B ASD* Names of the Stenographers who have been reverted after getting promotion (Permanent or adhoc) by the Head Office or Regional Offices.
- (4) *HRM-D* Copy of Head Office, New Delhi letter No. HRM-II/10(3)2000/PA/46366 dated 27-9-2006 in pursuance of which some stenographers were promoted on the post of PA.
- (5) *HRM-D* Whether the promotion to the post of Personal Assistant is being done by Regional Office level as per their Regional Office Seniority of Stenographer or by Head Office by operating the All India seniority list.
- (6) *HRM-D* Can the person promoted on regular basis be reverted back without giving any opportunity of hearing under the principles of natural justice?
- (7) *HRM-D / Jaipur* Provide me the copy of the proceedings of the DPC held at Regional Office, Jaipur on 17.1.2007 by which two stenoa were promoted on regular basis/adhoc basis to the post of Personal Assistant along with copy of review DPC held 27.10.2009 at Regional Office, Jaipur.
- (8) *MC ACR R.O.B HRM-D* How many stenographers out of the above mentioned seniority list (in Para 1) have been given the benefit of ACP Scheme. (Up to which serial number) copies of all the orders issued by Head Office/ Regional Offices giving the benefits of ACP Scheme be provided.
